

About the Director

Susan has been the director for Braintree Choral Society since the Winter of 2019. Prior to becoming the director, she had been the group's piano accompanist since 1996. In addition to directing the Braintree Choral Society, she was also the Music Director for the East Bridgewater Community Covenant Church until April of 2022.

During her musical career, Susan has directed and performed in hundreds of musicals throughout the South Shore, including with The Company Theater of Norwell, The Fiddlehead Theater of Westwood, Massasoit College Theater Group, and has served as Musical Director for Foxboro High School. Her love of musical theater began early when at age fourteen she started her own musical production company, C&G Productions.

An accomplished accompanist, Susan has performed with multiple choruses and orchestras in Massachusetts over the last thirty years, including Bridgewater State University Alumni Choir, Scituate Choral Arts Society, The Quincy Symphony Orchestra, and the Bel Canto Opera Company, to name a few.

Classically trained, Susan studied piano with Marlene Dubois, and Robert Brown, Conductor Emeritus of the Quincy Symphony Orchestra. Notable piano performances have included Carl Orff's Carmina Burana, Beethoven's Choral Fantasy, Poulenc's Chanson Gaillardes, Brahms' Vier Gesage Op. 70, and a childhood solo performance for the then Vice-President of the United States, George H.W. Bush.

Since 1990, Susan has taught hundreds of students in oneon-one piano instruction. In 2010 Susan retired as a piano instructor with the Braintree Public Schools in their Piano Conservatory Program.

Susan is honored to be directing this dedicated group of community singers in their historic 100th Season and is thoroughly enjoying this phase of her musical career!

Message from the Director

It is my sincere pleasure to welcome you to this historic 100th Anniversary Celebration Concert.

It is incredible that this group is marking it's 100th year of community performances on the South Shore, and as one of the oldest community choirs in the United States. The founder of the Braintree Choral Society, Cora Brooks, could not have imagined that the little chorus she started in her living room would be continuing in her work 100 years later.

The last four years have been difficult not only for Braintree Choral Society, but for all live performance groups. In the Spring of 2020, BCS was preparing for their Spring Concert when the Covid pandemic hit the United States and forced all live performances to cease.

When planning this concert, I wanted to ensure a celebratory atmosphere while at the same time honoring the difficulties that the world had shared through our pandemic experience, so I chose music that exemplified our recent human experience.

In Kevin Memley's Gloria in Excelsis Deo the cries of "Glory to God in the Highest" injects the celebratory atmosphere which is synonymous with our love of life, while the frequent meter changes mimic life's frequent changes, keeping us guessing where the music, and our life is taking us. In the middle section, the choir sings *qui tollis peccata mundi, deprecationem nostrum*" "You who take away the sins of the world, have mercy upon us – receive our prayer", shows the desperation many were feeling during the pandemic. Memley's final Amen movement assures the listener that they have been saved by the unknown and arrived home safely.

I hope the selections in this program will take you on a musical ride, striking the heart with familiar holiday songs, many played in a new and different style.

We look forward to another 100 years of great music!
